About the Academic Regulations (Apprentices)

The Academic Regulations (Apprentices) are the rules we follow when you join us to study as an Apprentice. The Regulations describe:

- how we make and communicate our regulations
- when and how we can make changes to regulations and curriculum
- registration for apprenticeship study
- study restrictions and time limits
- how we administer your academic credit
- our scheme of classification for undergraduate degrees and taught postgraduate qualifications
- how we award qualifications
- how your registration may be ended

You need to be aware

- We comply with Nation Funding Provider rules for apprenticeships.
- You and your Employer must provide information that we request in order to establish your eligibility to register. This information must be complete and accurate.

- These regulations should be read in conjunction with your qualification regulations which set out any specific academic requirements you will have to meet, and any exceptions to the general rules.
- When relevant we will follow related policies such as the <u>Fitness to Practise</u> <u>Procedure</u> for vocational apprentices, <u>Fitness to Study Policy</u>, and the <u>Code</u> <u>of Practice for Student Discipline</u>.
- We may apply conditions to your qualification registration or module enrolment if it is necessary to do so to comply with our statutory duties, for example in line with our <u>Safeguarding Policy</u>. Full details are given in the Regulations document.
